Class 1, Wednesday, July 10th, 2019 (Seminar Room)
Snook, Reds and Seatrout

These three species make up the 'Backcountry Slam' and are far and away the most sought after fish in the bays of Southwest Florida. We'll talk specifically about them and cover the best tactics for summer. Rods, reels, line leader, lures and bait are on the agenda, along with weather, tides and time of day.

Class 2, Wednesday, July 17th, 2019 (Seminar Room)
Shallow Water Trolling via Boats and Kayaks

Hey, why not? I've done this a lot and I guess it's time to talk about it. I doubt I can fill two hours with this alone, so there will be plenty of tips for trolling along the beaches and nearshore waters.
